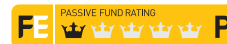

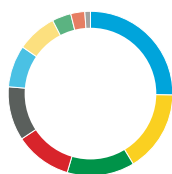

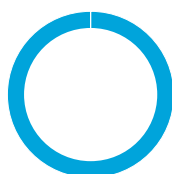

### INDEX FUND MANAGEMENT TEAM

The team has average industry experience of 15 years, of which seven years has been at LGIM, and is focused on achieving the equally important objectives of close tracking and maximising returns.
