FUND AIM

The investment objective of the fund is to provide long-term investment growth through dynamic exposure to a diversified range of asset classes. The long-term expected annualised rate of return for this fund is the Bank of England Base Rate +4.5% per annum, over a full market cycle.


WHO IS THIS FUND FOR?


FUND CHARACTERISTICS

The fund provides exposure to a range of different asset classes including equities, bonds, property, commodities and listed infrastructure, private equity and global real estate companies, which may be actively or passively managed. The asset allocation of the fund is managed by LGIM with the aim of enhancing returns and managing downside risk. The fund provides exposure to a combination of UK and overseas assets with a flexible approach taken to managing foreign currency exposure.

Derivatives may be used for efficient portfolio management.

FUND MANAGER COMMENTARY

The Dynamic Diversified Fund participated in the recovery over the second quarter and delivered a positive return.

The main asset-class contributions to performance came from equities and alternative credit. In particular, emerging market, North American, and Europe (ex UK) equities, and high-yield bonds and emerging-market debt added to performance. The allocation to gold miners added positively too.

In terms of detractors, risk management, UK government-bonds hedge and UK property made a negative contribution.

Within the Dynamic Diversified Fund we made the following changes over the quarter:

We added to US equities, tempering our cautious view on equities, though trimming the stronger-performing Nasdaq position. We added some exposure to laggards within Europe such as autos, which are a long-term value position. We switched circa 20% of the fund's equity exposure to the FutureWorld equity index fund equivalents (these funds tilt relative to a market-capitalisation approach based on LGIM's ESG score) via in specie transfers to help improve the ESG quality of the portfolio and mitigate some climate risks.

Within developed sovereign debt we increased our hedge on gilts, where yields look too low, and we believe it is unlikely that the Bank of England will move to negative interest rates. We added to our US treasury position and Australian bonds.

We reduced our exposure to investment-grade credit in the US and the UK on valuation grounds as the credit premium is no longer unusually high.

FUND MANAGERS

The Fund is managed by LGIM's Asset Allocation team. The team has a wealth of experience in fund management, investment strategy and economics. They are responsible for a wide range of multi-asset funds and investment strategies across LGIM's client base. The Fund allows a broad range of pension fund investors to access this expertise.

The day-to-day implementation of the allocation of the fund is managed by the Allocation Strategy Management team.
