## FUND AIM

The Fund objective is to provide a combination of growth and income within a pre-determined risk profile. The Fund's potential gains and losses are likely to be constrained by the aim to stay within the risk profile. The Fund also aims to incorporate environmental, social and governance considerations into the investment strategy.

## RISK PROFILE

The fund is part of a range of risk targeted funds. The risk profile ranges from 1-10 with 1 being the least risky, and 10 being the most. The fund targets risk profile 5. The level of risk in the fund is managed by restricting the types and proportions of the assets it holds. We have selected Distribution Technology as our current risk profiler. Distribution Technology are an independent agency who provide risk profiling tools to advisers and fund managers.

## WHO IS THIS FUND FOR?

- This Fund is primarily designed for investors: who have received advice and had their attitude to risk assessed and matched to the risk profile of this Fund but may be appropriate for those investors who have considered the risk profile of this Fund with the others in the Multi-Index range; who are looking for growth from an investment in company and government bonds (a type of loan that pays interest), cash, company shares and UK commercial property.
- Although investors can take their money out at any time, this Fund may not be appropriate for those who plan to withdraw their money within five years.
- This Fund is not designed for investors who cannot afford more than a minimal loss of their investment.

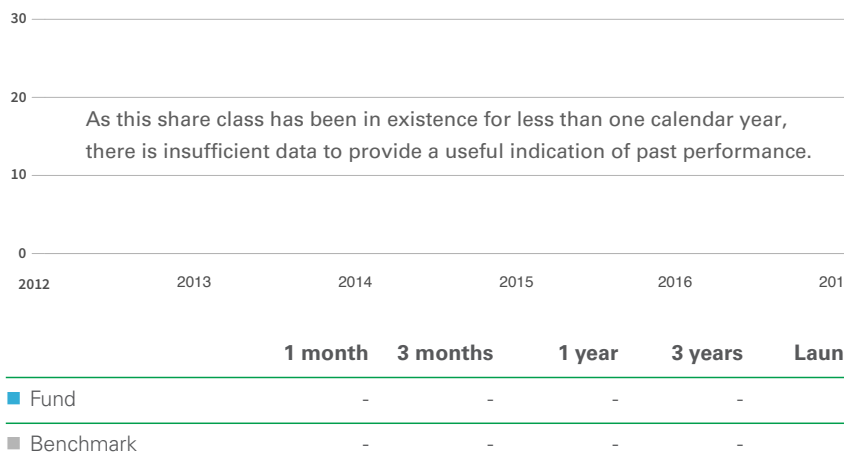

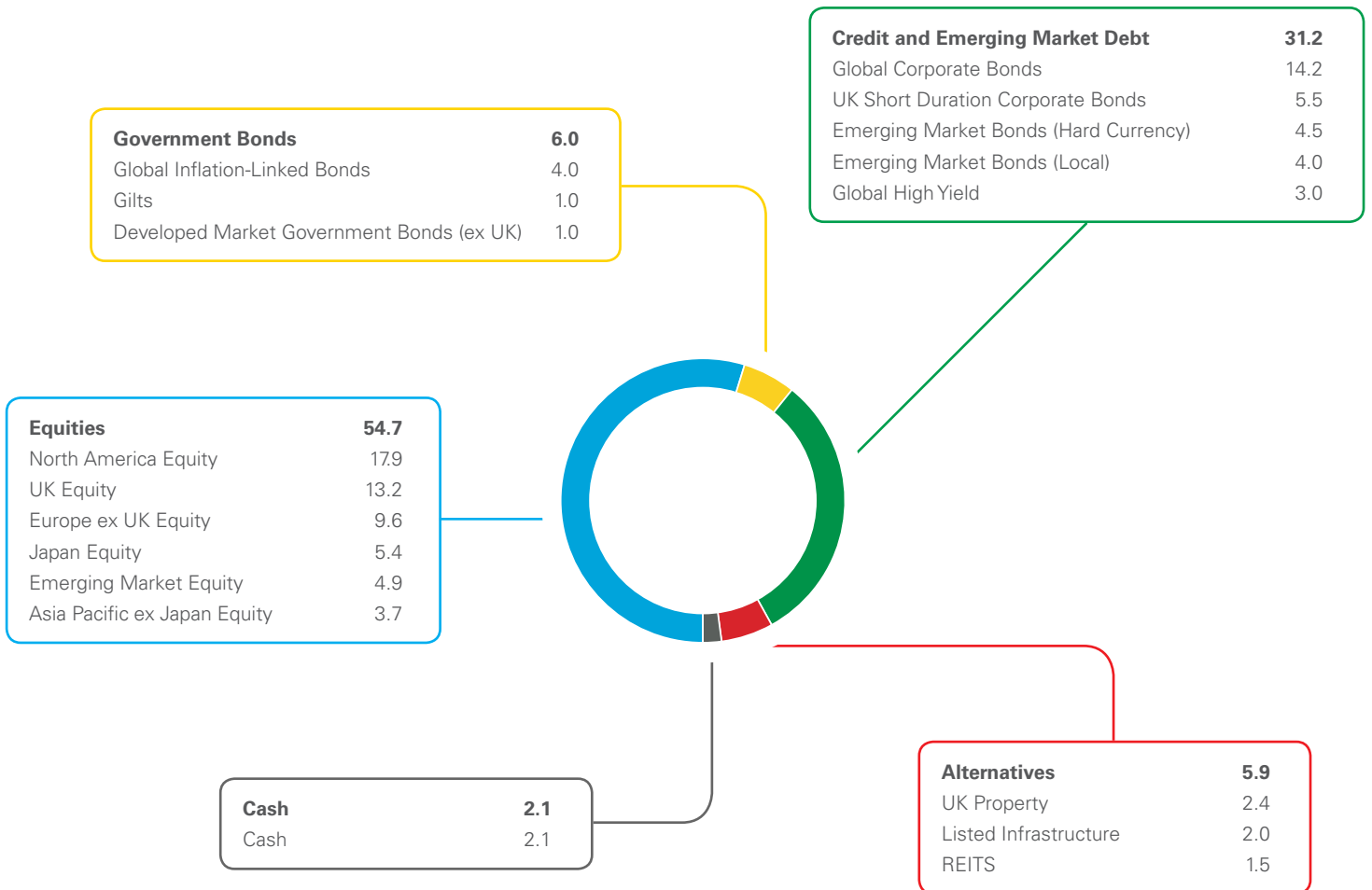

RISK PROFILE



The synthetic risk and reward indicator (SRRRI) is based on the historic volatility of the fund’s value and it may change in the future.

The fund is in category 4 because the mix of different asset types in which the fund invests has a balancing effect on the rate at which the fund share price moves up and down.

KEY RISKS
